Tribal Youth Art Contest

The Mattaponi Indian Tribe and Reservation will be represented at the Machicamaco State Park event on November 4th, 2023. One of the attractions will be searching for youth artists to create a sticker design that reflects their perception of the significance of nature to them and their tribe. Participation in this contest is to the members of State and Federally Recognized Tribes in the State of Virginia and is only open to school aged participants. The winner will have their design transformed into a sticker by the Park, which will be given away as part of the 2023 Indigenous peoples celebration that will take place in November.

In order to be considered, submissions must include the artist's name or initials, age, and appropriate contact information for their parent/guardian. By mail: Submissions can be mailed to the Park address as listed and must be post marked by <u>August 18th, 2023</u>. In-person: submission can be dropped off at the park office during open hours. The office is open 7 days a week from 9a-3p Monday-Thursday and 8a-5p Friday-Sunday. Email: A high quality photograph of the submission can be sent to courtney.kirberger@dcr.virginia.gov. Please keep the original copy until after the results of the contest have been announced. If you would like for the Park Service to mail a supply kit to the tribe, provide them with the appropriate mailing address to ensure supplies are sent to the correct location and/or individual. These supplies do not need to be returned.
